Research & Awareness

- Many GM1 caregivers participated in the study,
 "Humanistic burden of neurodegenerative lysosomal
 disorders in the US: insights from caregivers of patients
 living with GM1 and GM2 gangliosidoses", which
 highlighted caregiver and patient burdens and will help
 in future research.
- The Voice of the Patient report from the Externally-Led Patient-Focused Drug Development Meeting (EL-PFDD) was published on the FDA website, shedding light on patient experiences and most important symptoms to treat.
- TEGA received a Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) grant based on seed funding provided by Cure GMI to continue their Enzyme Replacement Therapy study.

Initiatives and Research Support

- Cure GM1 collected blood and urine samples to support newborn screening research at the Gelb Laboratory at the University of Washington. These samples will be used to further refine newborn screening research and assays for GM1.
- Cure GM1 joined CombinedBrain and initialized a patient-led GM1 bio-repository to collect and store samples from GM1 patients to be used in research.
- Cure GM1 and xCures initiated a collaboration to start a natural history study pilot.
